- Facilitate claims processing or medical referrals
- Host and secure our website and IT systems
- Analyse website usage (e.g., via Google Analytics). Whenever possible, the data collected from analytic tools is made anonymous or given a pseudonym to protect privacy.
- Comply with regulatory or legal obligations



Mediplus ensures data processing agreements are in place with all third parties, as required under POPIA. All third parties are required to respect the confidentiality of your information and comply with applicable data protection laws.

5. Your Rights

You have the following rights regarding your personal information:

- Access: Request access to the information we hold about you
- Correction: Request corrections or updates to your information
- **Deletion**: Request deletion of your data, subject to legal retention requirements
- **Objection**: Object to the processing of your information for direct marketing
- Withdraw Consent: Withdraw your consent at any time, where applicable
